By way of introduction my name is Dean Boxall and I am the Head Coach of St Peters Lutheran College, Indooroopilly in Brisbane, Australia.

St Peters Lutheran College is the location where the St Peters Western Swimming Club (SPW) train. We are one of the largest and most successful swimming clubs in Australia, known for our swimming excellence creating National, Commonwealth Games and Olympic swimmers.

I am pleased to provide a reference for one of our swimmers, Michaela Hazell.

Michaela has impressed the coaching staff with her ability, her commitment to swimming, her dedication and her resilience. Michaela has great speed, she loves to compete and she always demonstrates sportsmanship and determination.

Originally based out of Newcastle, New South Wales, Michaela and her family relocated to Brisbane in 2014 to pursue her sporting and academic ambitions. Michaela has smoothly transitioned into our swimming team (SPW) and is a popular member of the group.

Since moving to Brisbane Michaela had to have two knee surgeries and to our amazement she has showed incredible tenacity in still displaying a desire to compete at Australian National Age Swimming Championships despite only having a limited preparation leading into the championships.

It was due to this tenacity that St Peters Western Club in 2015 awarded Michaela an inaugural 'Courage' Award as she showed a fighter's spirit that, and every season.

In 2015 Michaela won six medals at the Australian National Age Championships, in 2016, with only two months (post-surgery) to prepare, she came away with three medals at Nationals and one Australian Age Relay record.

That was an outstanding result from Michaela and is testament to her ability and determination.

Not only did she make finals individually in her age group, she was a valued member of the St Peters Western's 14 years (2016) and 16 years (2017) Australian record breaking relay teams. Michaela has been an integral part of St Peters Lutheran College swim team, winning individual and relay team events in the annual Queensland Girls Secondary School Sports Association swimming competition including being part of record breaking relay teams.

St Peters Western is Australia's premier club and Michaela in the last three years has impressed the coaching staff with her tenacity in overcoming injuries and performing very well at the National Age Group level.

Michaela is always the first swimmer out on pool deck each morning for training and she is developing into a strong performer at Australian and Queensland swimming levels.

I would recommend Michaela for any club to invest in her as I believe she has the ability, and the character, to continue to develop into a great prospect for the future.
